▶ Evolution RAGE circular saw

£99.98

Don't fear, lumberjacks haven't invaded our office – this circular saw cuts steel. It'll slice through exhausts and box section up to 6mm thick. Equipped with a 185mm blade, the RAGE saw offers a 55mm max depth of cut. Unlike an abrasive cutter, surfaces leave the saw without burrs and it doesn't spark much when cutting. Each blade will cut up to 50m of 6mm steel before it needs replacing – our test tool has been pressed into a fair bit of service and still cuts well.
